Women's Ministry:

Feast not Famine/Holiday Market – Serve on the committee that designs, plans, and executes this fall outreach dinner and market.

Annual Women's Retreat – Serve on the committee that plans, organizes, and serves as the host group for an overnight gathering.

Come to the Table – This event highlights different ministry opportunities we have in our community and provides an evening of small group fellowship. Serve on the committee that organizes and implements this event.

Sacred Studio – The adult version of Created for a Purpose! Calling on creatives and logistical specialists – we need both! Serve on the committee that lines up the artists. Be a part of the creative team that determines the look and feel that makes this event special for members and guests. Pray together as we discuss and plan the worship and teaching time.

Ladies Missions Brunch – During the Missions Conference we invite our women missionary partners to enjoy a brunch in a member's home. We need women to plan the menu, the decorations, and a time of prayer for our missionary partners.

Summer Salad Suppers – During the summer months, Summer Salad Suppers combines fellowship, outreach, and feasting with stories from our sisters of God's faithfulness in their lives. We need ladies willing to organize and implement these suppers.

Lovelady Dinner and Christmas Concert – The lovely ladies from The Lovelady Center join us at Covenant for a festive dinner and concert in December. Their children enjoy dinner and a Christmas mini VBS. We need greeters, hostesses,

kitchen helpers, adults to help with the children's program, and many others to make this evening a special event for our guests.

Covenant Flower Guild – Members of our flower guild are responsible for the beautiful flowers that are in our sanctuary for worship each week. They are also called upon from time to time to help with other special events.

Creatif – Secures the artist and organizes the original artwork that is hung in the Commons and the Dining Room quarterly. This group also plans an opening reception for the artist.

Cooking Well – Cooking Well provides Covenant members an opportunity to meet with women from the Lovelady Center for a time of nutrition and cooking classes as well as opportunities to fellowship and build relationships.

Children's and Youth Ministries:
