

## CPC Women's Ministry Prayer Guide for Monday, January 4, 2021

### Adoration:

Oh come, let us sing to the Lord; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation! Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise! For the Lord is a great God, and a great King above all gods. In his hands are the depths of the earth; the heights of the mountains are his also. The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land.

Psalm 95:1-5

After this passage is read please pray short prayers of adoration, recognizing that our God is a great God and a great King above all gods.

Ingram will transition us from prayers of adoration to prayers of confession.

### Confession:

If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

1 John 1:8, 9

After this passage is read, confess your sins silently to the Lord or aloud.

### Thanksgiving:

And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

Colossians 3:17

After this passage is read please pray short prayers of thanksgiving. Some suggested topics include: immediate and extended family, church family, pastoral team, deacon, elders, women's shepherding team, staff, friends – believers and unbelievers, co-workers, health, activities, work, provision: home and food, challenges in your life.

### Supplication:

For freedom Christ has set us free, stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery. Galatians 5:1

After this passage is read please pray short prayers of supplication for others in our church body, that along with specific prayer requests that we as believers would live in the freedom that comes from being saved by grace.
