She will work primarily with the women in King's Table, Threshold, and College, but you will all have a chance to get to know her through Bible study, women's events, and other churchwide happenings. We are so excited that she is joining our church staff, so please make her feel welcome when you see her.

Even though summer has technically just started, I wanted to let you know about the Bible study we will be offering this fall. In the past we have generally studied a New Testament book in the fall and an Old Testament book in the winter. This year, however, we are going to take the fall and the winter to study Revelation. Nancy Guthrie has a new study on the book of Revelation called "Blessed." It is going to be a deep dive into the word of God that we will offer on Tuesday mornings. Small groups will also meet on Sunday nights and Wednesday nights. We are often intimidated by the book of Revelation, but John writes in Revelation 1:3, "Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear, and who keep what is written in it, for the time is near." If you are planning to participate in this study I would like to suggest the following:

- Read through the book of Revelation several times between now and September 13.
- We will have Revelation journals available at the church in July that you can pick up and use for this study.
